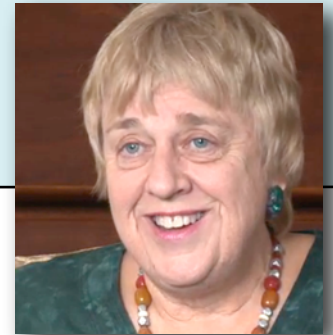

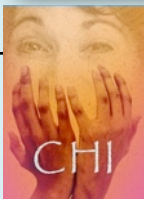
An evening with legendary Canadian filmmaker and storyteller Anne Wheeler.
